New Oscoda VA Community Based Outpatient Clinic Opening and Invitation to Open House

Veterans who receive care at the Oscoda VA Community Based Outpatient Clinic will be welcomed to a new clinic at the same address, 5671 Skeel Avenue, Oscoda, MI, very soon.

The existing clinic's space was no longer adequate. This new clinic will provide the same level of quality, safe care by a group of dedicated VA staff. Specifically, the clinic will have services for:

- Primary Care
- Lab Draws
- Women's Health
- Health Promotion and Disease Prevention
- Telehealth
- Mental Health
- Home Based Primary Care

The Aleda E. Lutz VAMC in Saginaw, Michigan operates an 81-bed skilled nursing and rehabilitation Community Living Center, with an additional 8-bed acute medicine and telemetry wing. It provides care to over 34,700 Veterans in a 35-county geographic area, from mid-Michigan to the Mackinac Bridge.
