## **Aleda E. Lutz VA Medical Center Flu Clinics Update**

The Aleda E. Lutz VA Medical Center has additional opportunities for Veterans to receive their flu shot. In addition to the drive-thru flu vaccination clinics, beginning September 25, 2020, Veterans may receive their flu vaccination in the main lobby of the medical center from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Veterans may also receive them at their scheduled face-to-face medical appointments. Our drive-thru clinics are scheduled from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., Tuesdays and Thursdays and are located behind Building 4. We request Veterans wear a short-sleeved shirt to receive the flu vaccine and of course please wear a mask. Flu clinic availability in the CBOCs vary by location and you can contact your local CBOC for dates and times.
